The main topic was how GWL can support the community and work together throughout the construction process and after opening.

It became clear that we need to meet with Stuart Adolph more regularly to discuss issues of concern and keep him informed of local developments such as the Ox RFD and the J10. In this context, we raised our opposition to the proposed Telecommunications Mast. We also raised the lack of clarity over the modus operandi of the shuttle service and the public bus service.

We spent some time exchanging some ideas on where support might be targeted:

- * The Burnehyull Woodland is especially linked to community and school use.
- * The Walliker/Keepax land on the Hale – GWL interested in looking at this for the PC – local landscaped areas
- * Entertainment - Movie Nights, Family Fairs (GWL quite keen on this area)
- * Improvements to the Playing Fields & Sponsorship of teams etc.
